Saturday, August 6 th	Cuttyhunk	<p>Town moorings in the inner harbor are first come, first served and are the recommended alternative. The Harbormaster monitors VHF Ch. 9, and will come by to collect \$40/night. Rafting of 2 to 3 boats permitted in good weather.</p> <p>Some transient slips are available at the town marina (508-990-7578), which is also the Harbor Master's office. Rate is \$2.25/foot/night.</p> <p>Moorings in the outer harbor are available from Frog Pond Marine (508-992-7530) for reservations at \$35 per night, or Jenkins Moorings on VHF Ch. 9 (reservations not accepted).</p> <p>Anchoring is permitted in the outer harbor. My cruising guide claims there's some anchoring in the inner harbor, but I wouldn't count on it.</p>	<p>Early arrival day</p> <p>Call in at 6:30 PM to organize evening margaritas</p>	<p>Fresh seafood is available from the "Raw Bar" boat that tours the Harbor from 5:15 to 7:30 PM, or from the fish market at the town dock, which includes cooked lobsters (ordered in the afternoon and picked up at 6:00 PM).</p> <p>Ice cream is also sold on the town dock.</p> <p>There is a small market on the island for provisions and sandwiches.</p>

Very little commercial activity, but a nice place to walk around. Swimming at Barges Beach on Vineyard Sound, or Churches Beach on Buzzards Bay.</p>
<p>Monday, August 8th</p>	<p>New Bedford distance of 12 N.M.</p>	<p>Moorings available from Whaling City Launch Service (a.k.a. Whaling City Expeditions). They're expecting us. Boats up to 45' at \$30 per night. Call 508-984-4979 directly to make your reservation and tell them you're with CCNE. Talk to Diane Stevens. Payment on arrival by cash or check. They do NOT accept credit cards.</p> <p>Slips are available for boats over 45', or those desiring a slip, at \$3.25 per foot per night, at Pope's Island Marina. Call them at 508-979- 1456 to make your own reservations. Talk to Debbie Yullie.</p>	<p>Cruise to New Bedford;</p> <p>(possible race, wind & weather permitting)</p>	<p>Launch service from Whaling City at a discounted rate for CCNE of \$3 pp, with a maximum of \$12 per boat, per trip (i.e. 4 or more people picked up or delivered to 1 boat is a maximum of \$12).</p> <p>Dinghy dock at the Coast Guard Pier (south side of State pier) next to Schooner Ernestina.</p>

Visit the Whaling Museum and/or the Seaman's Bethel (across the street from the Museum). Take in a show at the restored vaudeville Zeiterion Theater.</p>

Wednesday, August 10 th	Hadley Harbor distance of 12 N.M.	Anchoring in the inner harbor. Hadley Harbor has been included in the cruise in part, to make it easier to time our passage into and out of Woods Hole at slack tide.	Cruise to Hadley Harbor; (possible race if not held previously)	Enjoy a quiet harbor. There is a dinghy dock and picnic area on Bull Island (maintained by the Forbes family) that is open during the Summer.
Thursday, August 11 th	Lake Tashmoo distance of 5.1 N.M.	Anchoring toward the back (Southern) end of the Lake, for easier access to the town dock.	Cruise to Lake Tashmoo; (Possible cruise cook out depending on weather; we'll pick the better of Thursday or Friday evenings.) Jimmie Buffet songs and trivia contest.	Dinghy beach next to the town dock. Cruise cook out will be held at the Lake Street Park, maintained by the Town of Tisbury. The Park is a short walk from the town dock. Approximately one mile walk to Vineyard Haven. Taxi service is also available.
