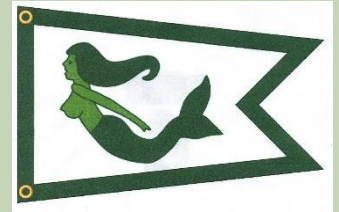

Block Island Mooring

For the benefit of our members, CCNE has a mooring at Block Island. It's important to keep the rules in mind when using the mooring so the maximum number of members may enjoy it, and to ensure that we keep our permit. The entire policy is attached, and will be posted on the website: <http://www.cruisingclubne.org>

Please note the Harbormaster's Regulations on the first page. CCNE's mooring permit could be revoked for: not flying the club burgee, excess number of yachts on the mooring, or sewage discharge into the town waters. If you use the mooring, please be familiar with the policies. If you have problems using the mooring, please let the commodore know.

Other key mooring reminders for the boating season:

- The maximum number of days allowed for mooring use during a boating season is six (6).
- The mooring cannot be used by the same boat on two consecutive weekends.
- The weekends immediately before and after the cruise are reserved for members' yachts who have signed up for the annual cruise. One must participate a minimum of four (4) days of the cruise to use the mooring on those weekends.
- Remember to fly your **club burgee** and leave **fenders** out for rafting!
